

Meadow Creek Cabin - Instructions

To Turn on Water To House

In downstairs bedroom closet locate the water valves for on/off. Pull red level vertical (up) for on and horizontal (down) for off. Water will generally be turned off and needs to be turned on.

Furnace Instructions

To adjust thermostat press “prgm” button on lower left of thermostat control on wall near kitchen under clock until you identify day and times. Next press up or down arrows to desired temperature. Push “prgm” again. You will have to push “prgm” several times so the heat will work continuously throughout your stay by selecting other desired times. For example, 6:00 am, 8:00 am, 5:00 pm, and 10:00 pm. You need to set the temperature on each of those times in order for the heat to be consistent the entire day. After pushing the “prgm” button and setting your desired temperature, push “run” button on lower left of thermostat controls for those settings to take effect.

Operating the Television (both in family room and master bedroom)

1. For Satellite

Push SAT button (top left). Push red TV power button (near top of control). Push red power button next to TV power button (near top of control). Push “guide” button to identify channel choice and push “select” button.

2. For DVD/VCR

Push red TV power button if the TV has not already been turned on using the above step for satellite viewing. Push TV white/clear button on top left corner of remote. Push TV/Video grey button until you see AV1 on the television screen. There is no remote for the DVD/VCR player so it must be operated manually. Push power button on the DVD/VCR player. Select “output” button to identify either DVD or VCR choice - a green light will show the selection. Upon inserting the DVD or VHS tape you should see your selection on the television screen. To return to satellite viewing, push “SAT” clear/white button located near left top of remote. Push left red power button on the remote (not the one marked TV as this will turn off the television).

Washer

The water valves may be turned off in laundry room. Behind washer will be the on/off valves for the water if the washer water is off.
